BC School Tracker Data - September 14, 2021

20 new exposures were reported at the time of this newsletter. There have been **53 exposures** reported in **week two** (Sep 11-17), and **60 total exposures** since week one.

Please note, four additional exposures occurred following yesterday's newsletter and were subsequently added. Exposure dates are reported in brackets. Bolded information released today. Since there are many exposures now, I have organized within health authority alphabetically by city, and then by exposure date within city. Hope this helps!

BC SCHOOL COVID TRACKER HOW TO REPORT A SCHOOL EXPOSURE

1 Get you or your family member **TESTED**, even if symptoms are mild.

2 If the test is positive email your school and BCC or CC us @ bc-school-covid@protonmail.com

3 **In the email include:**

- Confirm that someone in your household as tested positive.
- The date of the positive test.
- Dates of potential exposure (dates you or your family member were in the school while infectious).
- Name of the school.

BCCDC Dashboard - September 14, 2021

There were **677 new cases of COVID-19**, over the last 24 hours.

In the **past 24 hours, 10 people were hospitalized** within BC. **One death** was reported, for a total of 1,866.

Total Cases Children < 10: 10,730 (+244)

Total Cases Children 10 - 19: 19,417 (+338)

*Note. B.C. primarily only tests symptomatic children.

Of the 2,661 cases in B.C. since Friday, 582 cases were in children < 19.

Children < 19 accounted for **22% of the cases**.

Always Get Tested



Individuals across B.C. have reported being told they could not access a covid test, including in emergency departments. If this happens to you, ask them to document their refusal in writing and to get a photocopy of that note. It is legally your health information. You can also report your covid positive test to anyone you choose to. This is YOUR health information. Regardless of what they tell you. If they state you cannot tell anyone, again ask for written documentation of that statement.

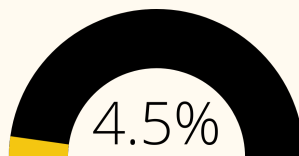
